**FEE:** OAG Members \$10/Non-Members \$15, for one or two entries, made payable to the Oklahoma Art Guild

**DELIVERY:** Deliver your work, entry form, and entry fee to the Kerr Auditorium on **Wednesday, September 8** from **11 am - 3 pm**, work will not be accepted late.

Works will be **juried on site at 5 pm on Wednesday, September 8**. You will be notified that evening by email or phone if your work was not accepted. If you do not hear from a member of the committee, your work will be on display and for sale during the Storytelling Festival.

**Not accepted work will need to be picked up Thursday, September 9th, between 12 pm and 2 pm.**

**COMMISSION:** 10% will be held
